Instructions for the day of the test

- Candidates are required to reach their assigned Test Centre on or before the reporting time indicated on front of this Admit Card. Any candidate reporting after the gates-closing time will not be allowed entry into the Test Centre under any circumstances. Candidates MUST bring the unsigned LSAT – India Admit Card (available on the LSAT – India website www.pearsonvueindia.com/Isatindia after the close of registrations) on the day of the test as they will be required to sign the Admit Card at designated place in front of the Invigilator, at the Test Centre. Another copy may be printed before the day of the test, if required.
- Candidates are not required to paste any photo on the Admit Card; as the Admit Card has printed photo as uploaded by them during registration.
- Misuse of the Admit Card will be treated as serious misconduct, punishable under the Terms and Conditions. Pasting any other photo
 or altering the printed photo in any way will lead to disqualification and faltering candidate will not be allowed to attempt the test.
- Candidates MUST use only a No. 2 or HB Pencil to shade the answer options in the answer sheet (OMR). Ink is not permitted.
- Only pre-registered Candidates with names appearing on the attendance roster along with Admit Cards and valid IDs (original and non-expired) from the list below will be permitted to take the LSAT – India:
 - Driving License
- Employee ID containing photograph & signature of the candidate

Military ID or military dependent ID containing candidates photo

- PAN Card
- Passport
- Election / Voter ID Card
- Photo identity issued by College/University containing Candidate's photo & signature

- If a candidate does not have any of the above identifications, he/she will be admitted upon presentation of any two of the documents (in Original) from the following:

• SC/ ST certificate with photograph

- Original Admit Card issued by University/ Board for Twelfth Standard Examination (containing photo)
- School Identity Card (containing photo)
- Tenth Pass Certificate/Mark Sheet that has photograph and date of birth on it
- Photocopies and attested copies of IDs are NOT acceptable. Candidates unable to produce valid IDs (original and non-expired)
 mentioned above will not be admitted into the testing room and shall not be offered a test-fee refund.
- Candidate's name on the registration form must match the IDs presented on the day of the test. Name changes MUST be supported by marriage certificate, divorce document or Government Gazette copy.
- Persons/ family members accompanying the candidate will not be allowed into the test premises, and no waiting area will be available.
- Candidates must adhere to the policies, rules and regulations which are available at the LSAT India website failing which they may be excluded from testing.
- Candidates are not permitted to bring mobile phones or any type of electronic device(s) to the Test Centre, as only Admit Card, valid
 photo ID, No. 2 or HB pencils, sharpeners and erasers are required for the test. All other articles will have to be left outside the Test
 Centre at candidates own risk.
- Only analog (non-digital) watches are permitted in the Test Centre.

Candidate's Undertaking:
