

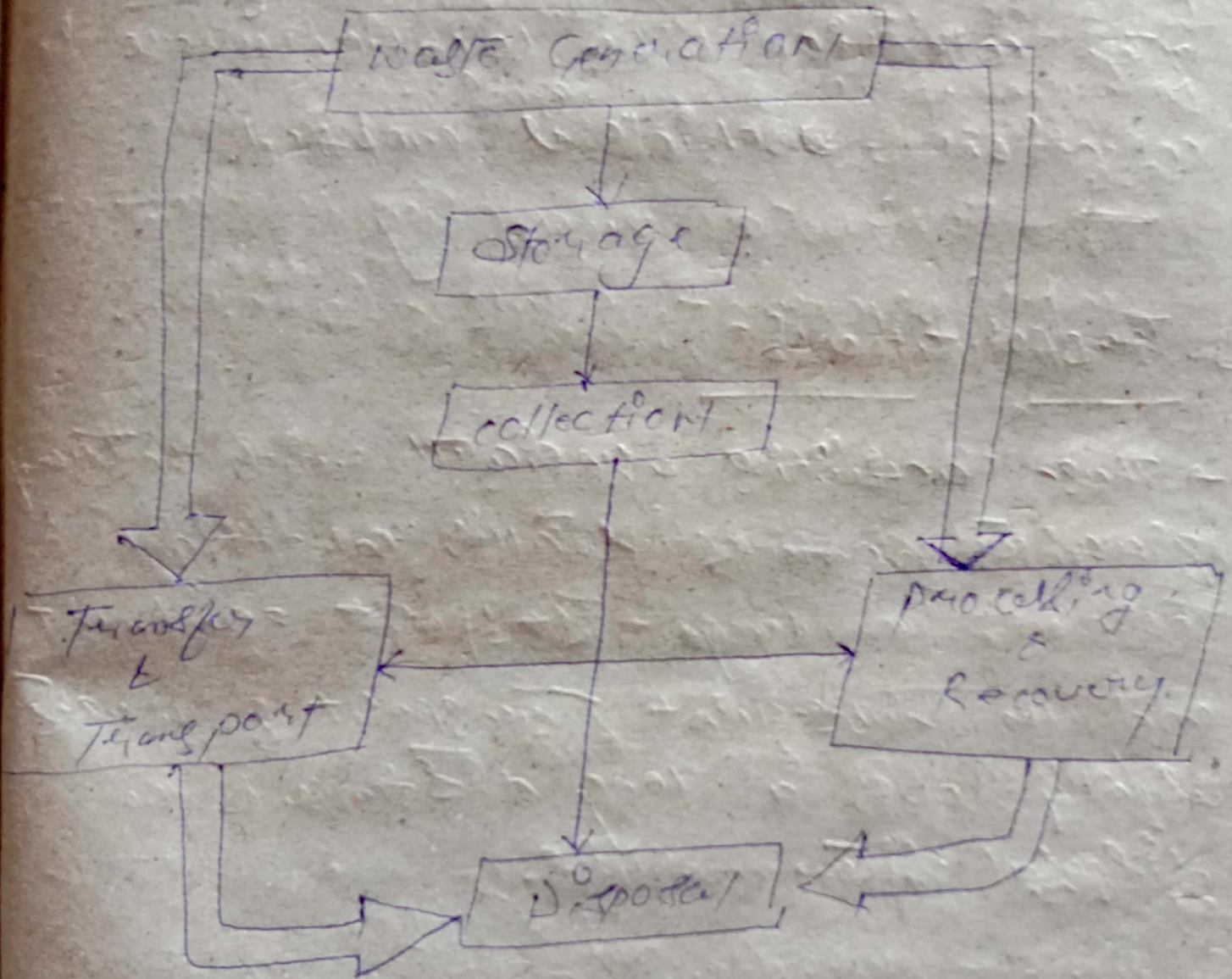
4: Functional element of Solid waste management & →

NOTE

1) Waste Generation

→ These activities in which material are associated with the handling, storage and processing of solid waste wastes at or near the point of generation.

Storage:

→ those activities associated with the gathering of solid wastes and the hauling waste after collection to the location where the collection @ vehicle is emptied.

Transportation:

→ These activities associated with the transfer of wastes from the smaller collection vehicle to the large transport equipment and the subsequent transport of wastes usually over a long distance to the disposal site.
