The functional element of solid waste management →

The functional elements of solid waste management are as followings

- 1.) waste generation → those activities in which materials are made, identified as no longer being of value and are then thrown away.
- 2.) Storage → those activities associated with the handling
- 3.) Collection → those activities associated with the gathering of solid wastes and the hauling wastes
- 4.) Transportation those activities associated with the transfer of waste management from smaller collection vehicle
- 5.) Processing and recovery → those techniques, equipment and facilities use both to improve the effective.
- 6.) Disposal → those activities associated with ultimate disposal of solid wastes including those waste collection and transported directly to the landfill site
