10/13/21 (A) Electronic Waste or E-Waste:-

- (1) Recycling and disposal of E-waste may involve significant risk to health of workers and their communities.
- (2) E-waste describes discarded by electrical and electronic devices.
- (3) Electronic scrap, trash components etc as CPU, monitor, Jc lead, cadmium, beryllium and flame retardants.
- (4) Used electronics which are designed for refurbishment, reuse, resale, salvage recycling through material, or ~~disposed~~ disposal are also considered E-waste.
- (5) Informal processing of e-waste in developing countries can lead to adverse human health effects and environment pollution.

(B) Hazardous Waste

(i) Hazardous waste is generated from source as, ranging from industrial manufacturing process wastes to batteries and they come in many forms, in which liquids, solids, gases, and sludges.

(ii) Hazardous waste is a waste with properties that make it dangerous or capable of having a harmful effect on human health or the environment.
