Selection criteria of sanitary landfilling.

- (1) Landfill area should not be very close to significant water bodies (water dams) -
- (2) There will be the risk of contamination of water bodies which can be hazardous for aquatic life.
- (3) The level of water in groundwater table be sufficient below the base of any excavation to enable landfill development.
- (4) The land which is significant environmentally the sensitive ecological area or such a land should be present within potential area of landfill site.
- (5) Land area and its volume should be enough to provide landfill capacity so that the projected need can be fulfilled for several years. In this way the cost subsidy on any part procedure procedure can be
