Email is emerging as one of the most valuable services on the internet today. Most of the internet systems use SMTP as a method to transfer mail from one user to send the mail another. SMTP is a push protocol and is used to send the mail whereas POP (post office protocol) or IMAP (Internet message access protocol) are used to retrieve these mails at the receiver's side.

### 2) File Transfer Protocol (FTP) :-

FTP is a standard internet protocol for transmitting files between computers on the internet. Like the Hypertext Transfer Protocol (HTTP), which transfers displayable web pages and related files and the Simple Mail Transfer Protocol (SMTP), which transfers e-mail, FTP is an application protocol that uses the internet's TCP/IP protocols.

### 3) Biometrics System :-

Biometrics systems are physical or behavioral human characteristics to that can be used to digitally identify a person to grant access to systems, services or data. Examples of these biometric identifications are fingerprints, facial patterns, voice or typing cadence. Each of these identifications is considered unique to the individual, and they may be used in combination to ensure greater accuracy of identification.
