

## # Communication Network :-

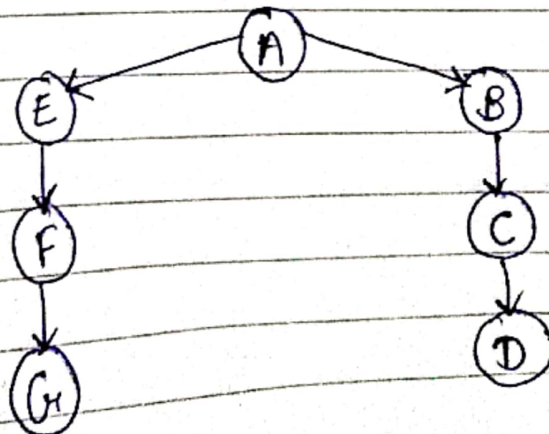
A communication network refers to the method that employees pass on information to other employees in an organization. Let's take a look at four different types: the wheel network, chain network, circle network, and all channel network.

### 1. Wheel Network :-

A wheel network is a style of communication where the leader is the only one to receive or give communication.

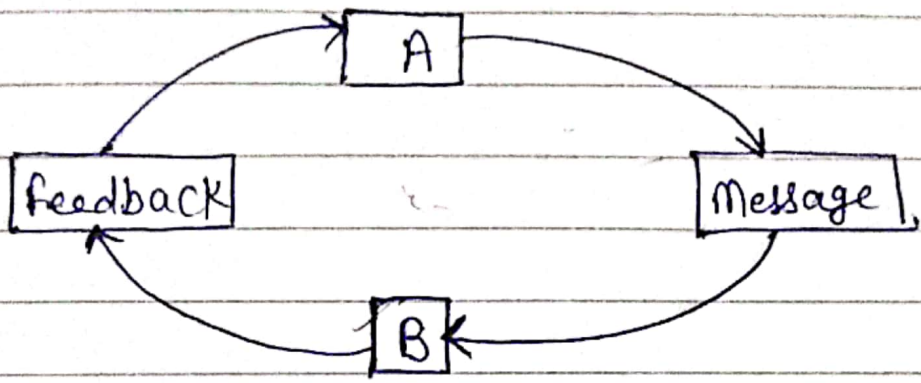
### 2. Chain Network :-

In a chain network individuals communication in a set sequence. Communication starts at the top, like from a CEO, and works its way down to the different levels of employees.



Circle Network :-

Under this network two persons communicate with each other. Say Mr. 'A' sends message to Mr. 'B'. After receiving message Mr. 'B' communicates the feedback message to Mr. 'A'. So communication takes the form of a circuit. Therefore it is known as circuit network.



All Channel Network :-

In an all-channel network, communication flows upward, downward and laterally among all members of the group. This pattern of communication supports an egalitarian, (equal, unrestricted) participative culture and fosters cross-functional efforts.
