

Directory authentication Service :-

You can use an external authentication directory Services (also called an enterprise directory or authentication login domain) to provide a single sign-on for groups of users instead of maintaining individual local login accounts. Each user in a group is assigned the same role. An example of an authentication directory Services is a corporate directory that uses LDAP (lightweight Directory Access Protocol).
