

Q2 Explain term protecting privacy  
Explain ethical & public  
policy issue.

Ans. Control over one's personal information is the concept that privacy is the claim of individuals, groups, or institutions to determine for themselves when, how, and to what extent information about them is communicated to others. Generally, a person who has consensually formed an interpersonal relationship with another person is not considered "protected" by privacy rights with the person they are in the relationship with.

- Several reasons can be identified which discourage issues from being defined as "ethical" issues in public policy making. However to avoid definition of issue as ethical problems tends to push aside some concerns which it is important to address as part of human life.
