

Q1) There are four different gauges.

- 1) Broad Gauge
- 2) Meter Gauge
- 3) Narrow Gauge
- 4) Standard Gauge (For Delhi Metro)

1) Broad Gauge:- The rails are separated by 1676mm of distance & it is the most used gauge in Indian Railways. It is planning to Unify all the gauges.

2) Meter Gauge:- The distance b/w the rails is 1000mm or 1m. Currently used in Nilgiri Mountain Railway and some other minor routes.

3) Narrow Gauge:- used in Kalka - Shimla Toy train. This is of two gauges - 762mm & 610mm

4) Standard gauge: It is a part from the above 3 gauges it is used in all the metro & trams in India use this gauge (1435mm).
