There are four different gauges

1. Broad Gauge \Rightarrow The rails are separated by 1676 mm of distance & is the most used gauge in Indian Railways. IR is planning to unify the all gauge

2. meter gauge \Rightarrow The distance the rails is 1000 mm or 1m currently used in Nilgiri mountain Railway and some other minor routes

3. Narrow gauge \Rightarrow used in Kalka Shimla Toy train. This is of two gauge 762 mm & 610 mm

4. Standard gauge \Rightarrow it is a part from the above 3 gauge it is used in all the metros & broad in India use this gauge (1435 mm)
