1.	The process of arranging data into different categories on the basis of nature, behaviour, or common characteristics is called classification.	A process of considering data and presenting it in a compact form, by putting data into statistical table, is called tabulation.
2.	Its purpose is to analyse the data.	Its purpose to present the data.
3.	It is done at the initial stage of data.	Process of tabulation starts after classification.
4.	Classification is a process of statistical analysis.	Tabulation is a process of presenting the data in suitable
