

(7) As a Result of the Green Revolution and the introduction of chemical fertilizers, Synthetic herbicides, and pesticide high-yield crops, and the method of multiple cropping the agriculture industry was able to produce much larger quantities of food. Despite increased land scarcity and the population roughly doubling the Green Revolution ensured that cereal crop production increased three fold. The Green Revolution (a term for rapid increase in wheat and rice yield in developing countries brought about by improved varieties combined with the expanded use of fertilizers and other chemical inputs) has had a dramatic impact on incomes and food supplies in many developing countries.
