(1) Meaning	Primary data refers to the first hand data gathered by the researcher himself.	Secondary data means data collection by some one else earlier.
(2) Data	Real time data	Past data

(4) Sources	Surveys, observations, experiments, questionnaire, personal interview	Government publications website books, journal, articles, internal records etc.
(5) Cost Effectiveness	Expensive	Economical
