
- PERCEPTION

Q8. What are the process of perception? Ans. Process of Perception:


The simplified model of perceptual process is given in the following diagram.



The above shows the interaction of four variables:

- (a). Inputs: The perceived inputs are objects, events, individuals etc that are received by the perceiver
- (b). Process: The received inputs are processed through the selection, organisation and interpretation. (c). Output: Through the processing mechanism, the output is developed. They are feelings, actions
- (d). Behaviour: Behaviour is dependent on these perceived outputs. The behaviour of the perceiver, in turn generate responses from the perceived and these responses give rise to a new set of inputs.

The process of perception is presented in the following two figure: (ii) Perceptual
