Ans -> 1 Root words -> (1) A basic word to which affixes are added is called a root word because it forms the basis of new word.

(2) The root word is also a word in its own right.

For ex- The word lovely consists of the word love and the suffix ly.

(3) A root is the basis of new word, but it does not typically form a stand alone word on its own.

For ex- The word reject is made up the prefix re- and the Latin root ject, which is not stand alone word.
