* PRODUCTIVITY MEASUREMENT:-

It is the ratio of a measure of total outputs to a measure of inputs used in the production of goods & services. Productivity growth is estimated by subtracting the growth in inputs from the growth in outputs - It is the residual. o.i.p.

Productivity is measured by comparing the amount of goods & services produced with the inputs which were used in production.

Labor productivity is the ratio of the output of goods & services to the labour hours devoted to the production of that output as per the aspects as a whole.
