Behaviorally anchored rating scales (BARS) are scales used to rate performance. BARS are normally presented vertically with scale points ranging from one to nine or an appraised method that aims to combine the benefits of narratives and quantified ratings by anchoring a quantified scale with specific narrative examples of good, moderate, and poor performance.
