iii) Sale of goods Act 1930 -

The Indian Sale of goods Act 1930, is a mercantile law, which came into existence on 1 July 1930, during the British Raj, borrowing heavily from the Sale of goods Act 1893. It provisions for the setting up of contracts where the seller transfers or agrees to transfer, the title in the goods to the buyer for consideration.
