Explain the steps involved in defining and formulating a research problem.

A research problem is a statement about an area of concern, a condition to be improved, a difficulty to be eliminated, or a troubling question that exist in scholarly literature, in theory, or in practice that points to the need for meaningful understanding &

deliberate investigation.

The techniques involving in defining & formulating a research problems are :-

- Statement of the problem in a general way.
- Understanding the nature of the problem
- Surveying the available literature.
- developing the ideas through discussions, and
- rephrasing the research problem in to working propositions.
