1. Natural Environment:

The Natural environment encompasses all living and non living occurring naturally. The term is most often applied to the Earth or some part of the earth. It is difficult to find absolutely natural environment on the earth and naturalness usually varies in a continuum from 100% natural in one extreme to 0% natural in the other. If for instance in an agricultural field, the mineralogical composition and the structure of its soil and similar to those of an undisturbed forest soil, but the structure is quite different. Earth science generally recognizes 4 spheres, the lithosphere, the hydrosphere, the atmosphere and the biosphere as correspondent of rocks, water, air and life respectively. Environment is defined as the total planetary inheritance and the totality of all resources. It includes all the biotic and abiotic factors that influence each other. While all living element the birds, animals, plants, fisheries etc. A study of the environment then calls for a study of the inter-relationship between these biotic and abiotic components of the environment.

2. Social Environment:

Social group, society, organization, community, political, economic, legal institutions come due to human relationship. Which affect from beginning of life up to death. And along with helps in socialization of individual. Every society constructs its own social environment. Some of the customs beliefs, practices and behavior are similar across cultures and some are not. For example an American traveling to Britain will find many familiar practices but not so much if travelling to china.

3. Cultural Environment
