A **research problem** is a statement about an area of concern, a condition to be improved, a difficulty to be eliminated, or a troubling question that exists in scholarly literature, in theory, or in practice that points to the need for meaningful understanding and deliberate investigation.

The Research Problem drives a study, and targeted, **in-depth research** is needed to fully develop **the Research Problem**.

Identification of research problem refers to the sense of awareness of a prevalent social **problem**, a social phenomenon or a concept that is worth **study** – as it requires to be investigated to understand it. The researcher identifies such a **research problem** through his observation, knowledge, wisdom and skills.
